One of the latest fabrics to be launched is **Elements** - a blackout foam backed fabric available in a 2.8M width that boasts easy maintenance and suits a variety of applications including Panel Glides, Roman Shades and Roller Blinds. Dual Roller Blinds are also an option with several of the Elements colours matched with many Hunter Douglas sunscreen fabrics.

Elements complies with the General Requirements of the Building Code of Australia for Fire Hazard Properties of materials in buildings. Not suitable for use in fire isolated exits of buildings.

Santiago Collection consists of two unique fabrics – **Revolve** and **Embosse** – each with a self coloured pattern with geometric circles and lines. Both are translucent and available in four neutral colours. Revolve comes in Cockatoo, Espresso, Natural and Blue while Embosse comes in Blue, White, Espresso and Natural.

Casablanca fabric is 100% polyester and sourced from Germany. This fabric collection has a unique metallic yarn which creates a soft shimmer look in several colours which include Bronze/Brown, Gold/Cream, Silver/Grey and White/Cream. Available in matching sheer and translucent opacities, the fabric can be used for Roman Shades, Roller Blinds and Panel Glide applications and is available in 2.4M width.

NOVASCREEN Sunscreen is woven from PVC coated fibreglass with a broken twill weave design – creating an openness factor of only three per cent¹. This fabric is dual sided with alternative light and dark sides. The benefit of this design is that the dark side offers good visibility and glare reduction while the light side, which will face out of the building, offers heat control.

NOVASCREEN Sunscreen complies with the general requirements of the Building Code of Australia for Fire Hazard Properties of materials in buildings.

NOVASCREEN Sunscreen is available in ten modern colours in a 2.5 metre width suitable for Roller Blinds, Panel Glide or Roman Shades applications. Both of these sunscreen fabrics achieve a rating of six to seven on the blue scale for UV colour fastness, ensuring they will not fade.
